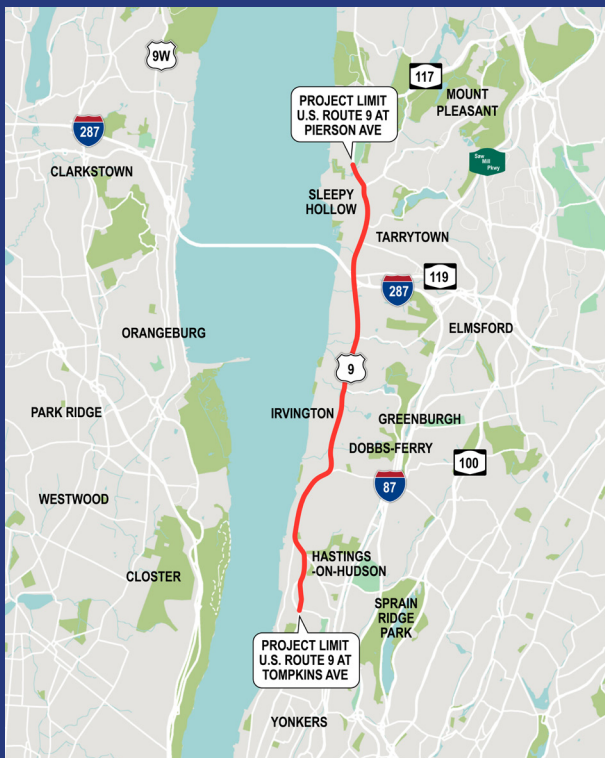
U.S. Route 9 Complete Streets Preliminary Engineering

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is conducting preliminary engineering activities for the U.S. Route 9 Complete Streets project. The project will prepare an environmental report that will propose a series of recommendations, including a preferred alternative capable of enhancing safety as well as pedestrian and bicycle facilities along U.S. Route 9.

The project limits will be from Pierson Avenue in the Town of Mount Pleasant, Village of Sleepy Hollow, to Tompkins Avenue in the Town of Greenburgh, Village of Hastings-on-Hudson.
